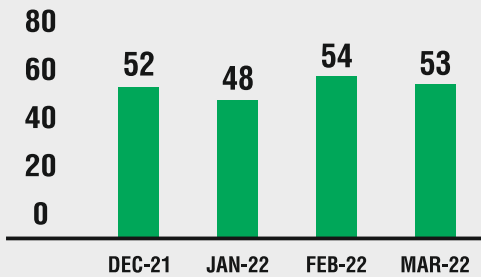

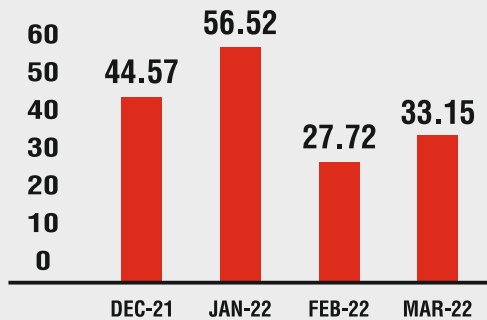

## MENSTRUAL HYGIENE MANAGEMENT

1. Securing the right to health in general and right to reproductive health for women in particular.
2. Affecting a socio-behavioural change in knowledge, attitudes and practices pertaining to menstruation among population at large.

The project helped providing supplementary employment to 250+ women as Sanginis in the Asani project. 500+MHM programme generated awareness amongst 15000 + women and adolescent girls from 400+ villages of 8 blocks of Bharuch district.



## ASANI SANITARY NAPKINS PRODUCTION UNIT

Bridging the literacy – employment gap by nurturing a social entrepreneurship ecosystem focused to women & also led & managed by women.

The Asani sanitary napkins manufacturing unit being one of its kind in the entire tribal district of Bharuch and Narmada, fully managed by women. Intensive capacity building and training of these women who had hardly completed their formal primary education, have led them to form a successful entrepreneurial group of 11 members – cooperating not just for their social and familial matters but more importantly taking concrete steps towards accessibility and ownership of financial resources, availing banking facilities and thereby gaining empowerment.

The product developed by these women i.e. Asani ultra-thin sanitary napkins are gel based. The women take due care in maintaining the quality of the product from purchase of raw materials to delivery of the product to the end user as it is a product owned, sold and utilised by women themselves.





## MEGA HEALTH CHECK UP CAMP

Medical camps provide free medical advice, medicines to the underprivileged people and refer for specialized treatment or surgery whatever is required. These camps make sure people are getting healthcare at the right time, and getting the consultation early enough before a small health problem turns serious.

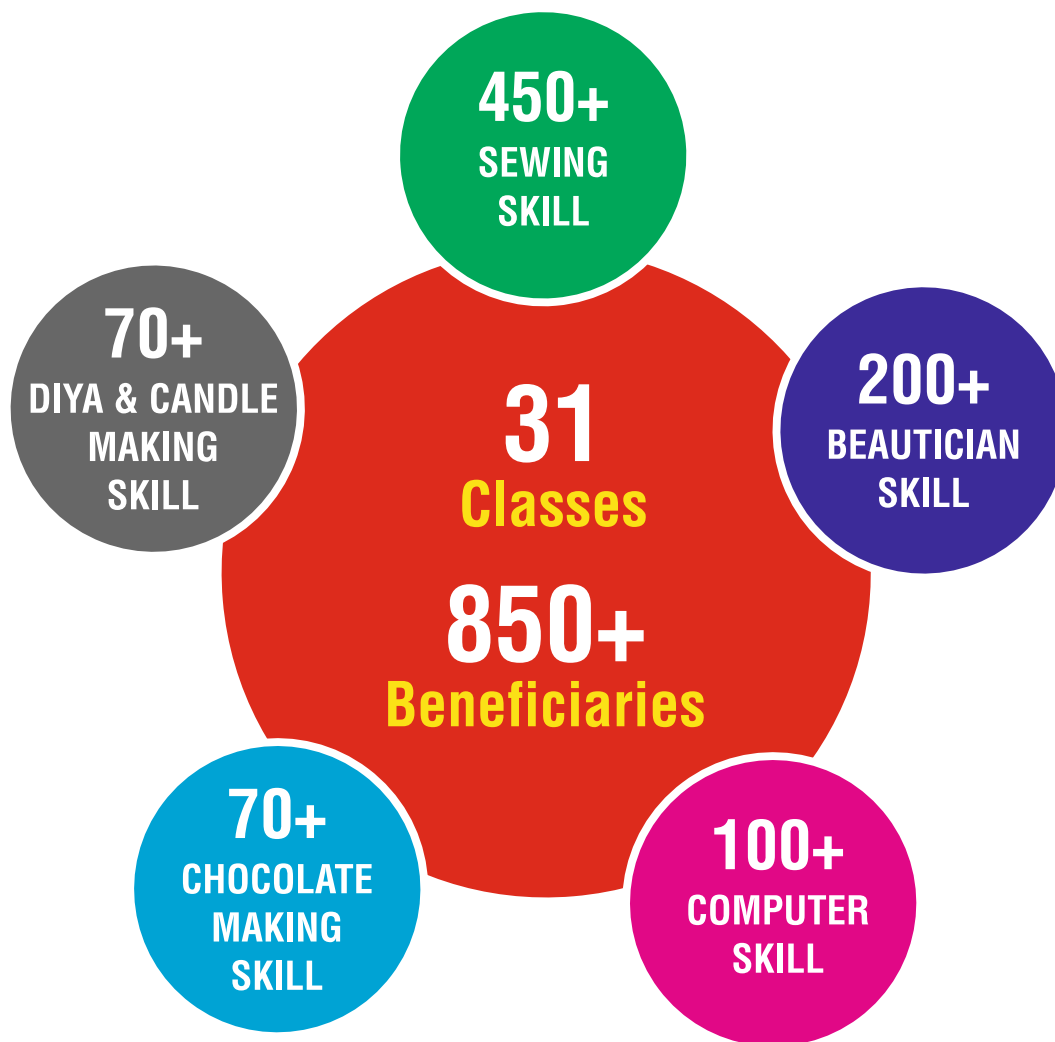

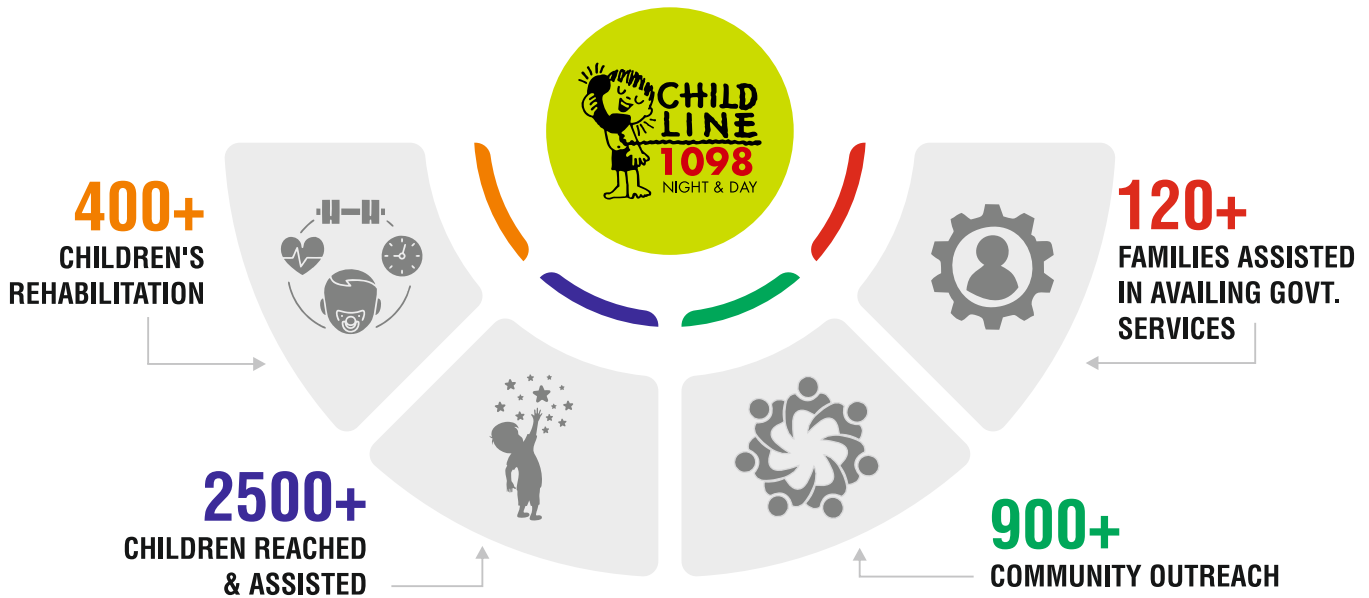

# SUCCESS STORIES



Afrosha is one such empowered sangini in her prime at 20 years, identified during one of our menstrual health awareness programmes at Vagra village of Vagra block in Bharuch district; who started from a sale of 15 packs of sanitary napkins a month to an average of 400 packs per month assisted with our capacity building initiatives to earning approximately Rs.2,000/- that helps in sustaining her family. This also has aided our sangini Afrosha have accessibility & ownership over the financial resources at her disposal and thus giving her a say in the domestic decision making process too, which otherwise is not the norm in the community she hails from.



## BICYCLE DISTRIBUTION PROGRAMME




Providing accessibility to education forms a basic part of the right to education concept. Especially in rural and remote areas of nada village, dabhoi block, the Gram Vikas Trust successfully secured the right to education and right to mobility of 22 children by providing bicycles to them. This has not only reduced their absenteeism in the school but also has a positive impact on the reducing the school drop out too.

A case of 05 year old girl child registered at Childline Bharuch on 22nd June, 2022. It was a medical emergency during travelling which needs an urgent and quick response to which our team had an interaction with respective railway authority to cater the services. The child had frequent vomiting and headaches so her father took the Bharuch child line and asked for help. Date: On 22/06/2022 at 10:35 am a call came from Mumbai CCC. The caller said the child father himself was a caller who told me that my daughter was very ill and that we needed medical help. The team spoke to Bharuch station master and said that a girl in Swaraj Express train needs medical help. Checking in Swaraj Express train by Bharuch station master and then medical help was given to the girl at Bharuch railway station. Her father called and said that the child was in good health and thanked the Bharuch Child Line team.
