



Similarly the women in backward communities who were neglected, oppressed and exploited socially, economically and politically are now placed on a pedestal. The Self Help Groups of 2500 women, over four years. In the process these semi-literate rural women have demonstrated leadership, community organization, collective will, mutual respect, confidence, honesty, and business acumen.

#### Child Rights for the change;

GVT works in Bharuch District and on a state level work in collaboration with **SAVE THE CHILDREN** and other partner NGOs on advocating for progressive change in policies-with a move towards inclusion of agricultural work as hazardous for children.

This program covered many sub programs which directly or indirectly local community of village. The Major area of work on the issue is child rights, whereas the other area includes child abuse, neglect and exploitation. The children are empowered through education and by fostering of solidarity amongst them through children organizing various events including street play etc. The children who are part of the non-formal education program are trained and oriented on elementary education and are later enrolled in formal schools. The children of the non-formal education like kidagan and extra classes are provided with school educational aids such as books, toys etc.



Such as during the year of 2011-12 variousactivities are carried out at the grass root level through various local institutions such as child groups, Child protection committee, women self-help groups, School Management comitee.

#### **Success Story**

#### CPC'S REGULAR FOLLOW UP MADE VISHNU BACK TO SCHOOL

#### Teacher says "Vishnu comes to school regularly now."

VILLAGE: MALPOR, BLOCK: ZAGHADIA, DIST.: BHARUCH

This is Vishnu's story which was informed by CG during Life skill Training. In this story orphan child Vishnu became irregular due to loneliness. Earlier he used to go to school with his brother but after his brother joined High school in zaghadia, He became irregular in school but CPC's efforts worked and he came back to school.

Malpor is 8kms.far from Zaghadia and 39 kms far from Bharuch. Malpor has 1100 population and all are trials. There is a primary school till std.8 and 162 (82boys, 80 girls) children are studying in this school. Vishnu is one of them. He is in standard 3.

Vishnu has 3 elder brothers. Two brothers are in zaghadia high school. Biggest brother is an agricultural labour. His father stays alone; he drinks liquor all time and never gives money in house. Vishnu's mother got second marriage and left whole family with small girl child when Vishnu was studying in std.1. Vishnu and his brothers are staying with their grandmother named Lalitaben. Lalitaben is working as a domestic helper in Bungalows at zaghadia. Since last year Vishnu was regular but from this year his elder brother came into high school and he had to go to Zaghadia for further study. So Vishnu became alone at home. Every day early morning Vishnu's two brothers go to school, elder brother goes to farm and grandmother goes to household work in bungalows.

So Vishnu used to play whole day in village. He goes to school without having bath, wearing dirty clothes. Teachers send him to have bath and change clothes but Vishnu never return to school later on. He used to play in village, when his grandmother came home he came with his grandma. Slowly he ignored to go to school and run away for playing.

DA (Dharmishtaben) told Vishnu in life skill training to come with having bath and wearing clean clothes. She also told to cut the hair all time Vishnu's reply was YES but never act. CG group said "Dharmistaben Vishnu does not come to school, when teachers sent him to have bath he would not come back to school and just play whole day in village. DA decided to meet his grandmother, next day she went to Vishnu's house with two CPC members named Ushaben and Jeevanbhai. They told all about Vishnu to his grandmother Laliataben.

Lalitaben Called Vishnu and told him having tears in eyes "Vishnu why you do not go to school? You must go to school alone with wearing clean clothes. Your father does not give money for food. If I stay at home for your school what about our daily food? Your mother run away keeping all of you here, your mother does not think about you. I will give you food till my life but what about after my life?" After home visit Vishnu did not go to school but Dharmishtaben and CPC members (Ushaben and Jeevanbhai) regularly visit him and at last got success to send him back to school.



When DA (Dharmishtaben) visited school teacher Bhavnaben told "Vishnu comes to school regularly now."

CPC members said "It is our duty to keep watch on school, we will regularly visit school and not any single child would drop out."

#### CASE TRACKING OF PREVENTS CHILD MARRIAGE -

Bharuch District was located in Southern Region of Gujarat. This District was big Industrial Hub in not Gujarat But in India or Asia. Most of population was Developed but in partial area some Tribal Pocket. In Bharuch District Zagadia is very underprivileged area, due to less education, Poverty.

Zagadia is 25<sup>th</sup> kilometer far from District Place. Dhodakuva is village of zagadiataluka and Mrs. Laxmiben works as Development activist with GVT. Development Activist major role is awareness in the village for Child Rights, cut the numbers of Child Labour, combat with Child marriages, Child Abuse and as on. They very well know about Child Marriage Law and spread since three years. On the date of 09/02/2012 once training held in village Kharia, once 13<sup>th</sup>



years girls not come in this training because her family members arrange her marriage with the boys of Ahmadabad and today day of Haldis, this information she get from C.G and others girls.

D.A. Laxmiben meets her girl and inquiry about marriage than she girl fill Comfortable and express her filling front of her. They girl was crying and tells laxmiben they don't want to marriage. After laxmiben meets with her parents and trying to convince them stop this marriage. In the girls house the father of girl was died and step father was present. The family member forceful tries to complete the marriage. After that laxmiben was return office and tell this truth about the marriage to program Officer Mr. Chetambhai and program manager Mr. Brijeshbhai. And in the organization all P.O, P.M, C.C. and D.A. seat to gather and discourses about what is the solution or next step of this. All member of organization immediately visit the girl's home and trying to convince her family members. But in the family give argument with them and tell the girl have no father and who care of the girl, girl was very problem for family and the boy's family was well settle and rich etc. they also trying to convince broker or Agent of who arrange this marriage but his also give excuses. the team of GVT was understood in this marriage some dealing of money by broker/Agent. they family also sing a song of Poverty.

Last they family not convince for GVT team member, the Program Officer Chetanbhai give detailed information to C.W.C. and C.W.C is very positive response and inform the District Superintend of police on the Date: 10/02/2012 Saturday give return application of this circumstances, for stop this Child marriage. The next day the girl's marriage is comes on the Date: 11/02/2012. All villagers and C.C and D.A. give positive response and support of stop the marriage. Though the marriage stop on the day so all area get I beautiful massage.

On the day Date: 11/02/2012. The Barat comes in khariya village (the marriage boy come with family for marriage). The time was start of countdown of marriage ceremony but no single police comes in the village, all villagers and C.C. and D.A. call on call of Program Officer Chetanbhai. Program Officer Chetanbhai also contact of DSP office and local police station in Zagadia. But they were Problem of official procedure. Program Officer Chetanbhai give G.V.T. & SAVE THE CHILDREN to police station. They get answer from police station; this marriage is arranged by girl so we can't do anything. Last they give information about the application of DSP office by C.W.C. so police come in alert and finally Police Jeep comes in village Stop Marriage.

We organized exposure visit for the STP children to teach science and mathematics with effective learning method and experiments (water pressure, magnet, and gravitation), Children were more than excited and happy for it and wanted a learn more and leaned poems in Gujarati and Marathi which was a fun activity for them.

#### THEATRE DRAMA ON RTE/SMC:

Introduction: After having SMC training for all SMC members, people were not aware of RIGHT TO EDUCATION. Even when government arranged SMC training people did not turn up for it and therefore main objective of RTE/SMC could not be spread and thus we decided to perform street play in all villages on RTE/SMC after the meeting of all POs at SCBR –Ahmedabad.

In this meeting it was decided to play a small DRAMA in all villages and for that a professional team had to be hired and it was implemented only after the agreement of all the members.



#### Objectives:

- · To bring awareness about RTE among village people as well as SMC members
- · SMC will be able to perform her duty
- SMC will have school visit regularly
- · People take initiatives for implementation of RTE

#### Process:

After the meeting, we announced in all villages about the upcoming drama event before starting but people did not show up. So later on we decided to arrange this drama in the middle of the village people so that villagers saw and appreciated it. In the Vesadada village a person named Ganeshbhai told "Amara gamma aavi rite SMC banelnathianebalako 5 ane 6 ma bhanta hoy to pan temnevanchtalakhtaaavadatunathi."

- 1. Children could not read and write.
- 2. Teachers are not regular
- 3. SMC have not made through Gramsabha as per RTE?
- 4. People do not know about SMC members.

All these stages are correlated with each other. One cannot go directly to 3rd or 4<sup>th</sup> stage. She/he has to learn from the first stage. We had already finished our first two stages. And this is the third stage of the training. Before this training we had taken TOT at BSC- A'BAD given by Save the Children.

**PROCESS:** We arranged two days training as we were told after TOT. We (Dipakbhai, pravinbhai and I) discussed who will take which topics and time duration of each activity. We covered information of all 5 stages of the module, observation, activities related to observation that we learnt in TOT

#### LEARNING:

- · Importance of observation.
- · Education from different places, and from each thing.
- · Learning from Nature.



#### **Quality Education (Sikshna Project)**

Sikshna is essentially a program aimed at evolving a sustainable and replicable model for the public education system at primary level. it has been in existence for about one and half years, with the coverage increasing from three in the first year of its operation to 15 in the second. Sikshna has been able to show significant and measurable improvement in the learning levels at a typical cost of not more than rs 55100 per annum in a typical school of 150 kids.

The school which have gone through this program for one and half years and showing encouraging results, indicating that it is feasible to have a permanent and lasting impact over a

5 to 7 year period.

we operate this project in the facultative mode in the filed so that the local community does not start looking at us as a source of revenues but goes on to develop over a period of time adequate skills to manage the school on their own.

The basic objective of this programme to facilitate C grade children and uplift their creativity and to teach basic which is they have learn in school. We taught them as smooth way like play game and sing a song. This activity has been very helpful in GUNOTSAV programme (Government assessment in 24-25 November) of school. We also provide them black slate, pencil, rubber, notebook, etc.

#### **Support Education Programme....**

#### Bicycle Make A History In The Aladar Village

Gram Vikas Trust started this initiative program in support of girls for who wish to continue higher education. Under this program young girls get bicycle to continue higher education. Lack of transport facilities force girls to drop out from school after 7th grade. Gram Vikas Trust have provided bicycle to hundreds of girls. Bicycle program helps them to travel and continue high school. After high school they also entered graduate program. Gram Vikas Trust also organizes five days residential "JivanUtkarshSibir" (career development) for these girls.

The Aladarvillage of Vagra block has up to 6th standard Government run primary schools. Since 2009 none of the girl children enrolled in 7th standard. No girl children educated up to 8th standard from the village. The Female Literacy rate of the village is also lowest in the block. 100 % drop out rate among the girl children after 6th standard. In the year 2009 onward Gram Vikas Trust decide to provide Bicycle to



each girl who passed 6th standard from the village school and enroll them in nearby village Goladra in 7th standard. Since 2009 onward 100 % girls from Aladar village enrolled in 7th standard and after 7th standard they enrolled in 8th standard in Kadodara village for studying upto10th. This is the history in the village that bicycle motivate girl children and parent to reduce drop- out rate from 100 % to 0 %.

All the village girls are really happy that they got their own bicycle thanks to the help of the donators and so they wants so say "Thank you" to all people who show interest on the needs from rural girls like them.



This year in 2011 we have donated 250 more bicycles to the school girls in drought prone villages of Vagra block of Bharuch District..

I am thankful to the donors who have supported theses young girls to dream whatever they wish to. We greatly appreciate all the support you have given us so far and hope that you will be able to help us in for our future projects.

#### Note book Distribution in Bharuch and Zaghadiya Block villages...

During this Year We have distribute Notebook to all children who are study in primary school of Bharuch and Zaghadiya block. It Distribute to 5 to 7<sup>th</sup> standard student for a purpose that every child got equal education and for that they have to need a good educational supplies, Inspite of unavailability of educational material or scarcity of this material many Children became ir-regular and Drop-out because of with compare of other children of their classmates they have not enough school material. So that Gram Vikas Trust has taken initiative for providing notebooks to them, and makes them regular in school.





#### Women Empowerment

We work Under NABARD Project as formatting women Self help Group, NABARD is basically work for the women empowerment. So in this project we do formation of Self Help Group (SHG). After formatting group of women by Deciding some rules and regulation of regular saving in group. It helps women in their crises.
